The Board meets formally on at least 8 occasions during the year (see Calendar) and within the bounds of the Education Act (1989) and subsequent amendments and the Pasadena Intermediate School Charter, is responsible for school governance.

## SINGAPORE, JAPAN, CHINA, KOREA

On behalf of the school, in Week 10 of Term III and the first 10 days of the School Holidays, I travelled to Singapore, Japan, P. R. China and South Korea.

In Singapore, I visited a reputable International School to view the latest curriculum developments and observe in classrooms. While International schools are reasonably well resourced and class sizes are generally lower than in NZ, unfortunately testing, marks and grades continue to lock their curriculum and methods in the 20th century.

In Japan, on behalf of Pasadena I attended the opening of Nagisa, Hiroshima High School and Junior High School, our Japanese sister school's, impressive new campus. At the official luncheon I was invited to make a speech and propose the official toast. I also met with the Senior Managers at the school, to review and reaffirm our Exchange Programmes.

Following on from an introduction by Western Springs College, last term we hosted Principals from the Jingying Education Group from the Peoples' Republic of China. The Jingying Education Group is based in the 4.5 million provincial city of Shijiazhuang 2½ hours south of Beijing. The flagship school of the group, has a student population of 6½ thousand in primary, intermediate and secondary departments – all boarders! The school leaders are becoming increasingly concerned about their students becoming disinterested in and disconnected from, the curriculum. After seeing Authentic Task in action, they invited me to visit their school and to talk to primary and intermediate teachers about our approach. Both schools have agreed, a continuing relationship will be beneficial to both.

With the loss of the Telecom School Connection Programme funding, the Board is considering other sources of income, including international students. The South Korean Government is promoting and supporting 'conversation English' in schools. With this support, Korean schools and parents are looking to 'safe' English destinations for international interschool relationships and international student placements. While in Korea, I met with the Governor of Cheong Ju Province Education Authority, visited and signed a sister school agreement with Gakri Middle School, they will visit Pasadena in January 2009 and met with 16 parents interested in sending their children to NZ as international students for an English language learning and experience.

The 2008 Prospectus and Calendar details the expectations and standards of personal behaviour we have of all students.

Page 10 STUDENT WELFARE, PASADENA INTERMEDIATE SCHOOL CODE Items 4, 5, 6 & 7 detail these expectations very clearly -

- All students are expected to be courteous and sensible at all times. They are expected to allow others to learn without interruption.
- Students are expected to be sensitive to the feelings of others and to display tolerance of difference, including gender, race, culture, religion and ability.
- Assault, violence, physical abuse, verbal abuse, bullying, social, sexual, religious, physical, intellectual, cultural, age, gender harassment and foul language are considered anti-social and unacceptable forms of behaviour.
- All students are expected to be honest. Property and possessions belonging to others will be left alone.

This information is also on Page 17 in the Student Information Book.

The warm atmosphere, supportive tone and cooperative student attitude are characteristics of Pasadena Intermediate School that authorities and visitors regularly comment on. We would be grateful of your continued support in maintaining these standards.

Students who consider they are the victims of any of the above anti social behaviours are encouraged to speak up and are supported 100% by the school and staff.

Sometimes however, there are students who feel afraid to speak up, who feel reporting the matter may further compound the problem for them - this is not the case.

If you are aware your child is suffering because of other student/s behaviour and they need help in dealing with the problem - we want to know.
