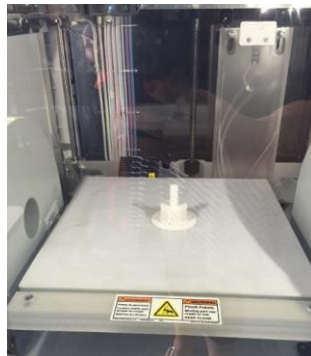

### *3D Printing*

Forrest, Angus and Charles started a 3D printing inquiry when one of the feet fell off the bottom of a high chair in room 4.

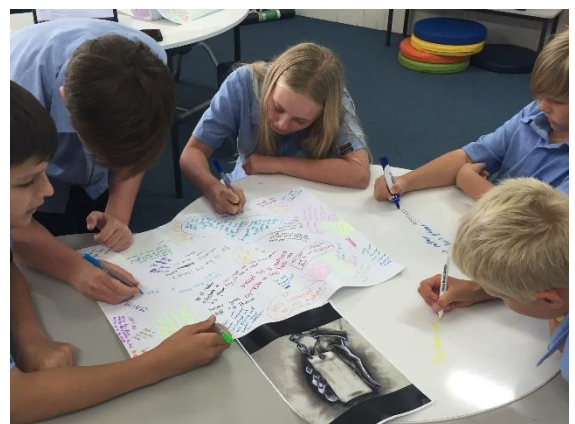
First we measured the hole in the bottom of the chair and made a basic prototype on Tinkercad (a 3D printing programme). The first design fitted perfectly, except it wasn't tall enough which meant the chair was still wobbly - so we had to redesign it. When we took the first prototype and the new design to Mr Hughes, he said to have another look in the chair for something small to hold the foot of the chair in place. We looked at the other feet on the chairs and found out that there was a washer helping it spin as well as holding it in place. Now we are going to print the new and improved prototype of the foot with the added height and washer.
