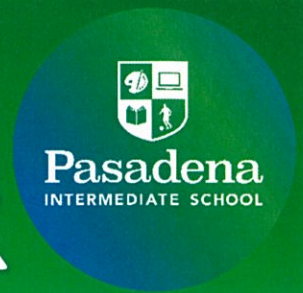

Last week was a great success due to our amazing students and the huge number of adult support. A MASSIVE thank you to everyone who came, assisted and supported our students!

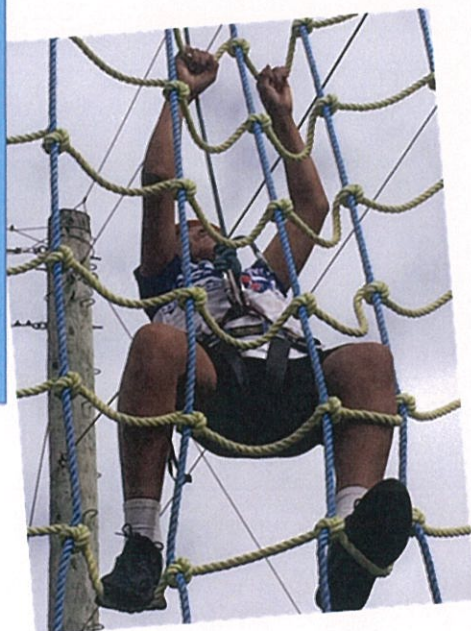


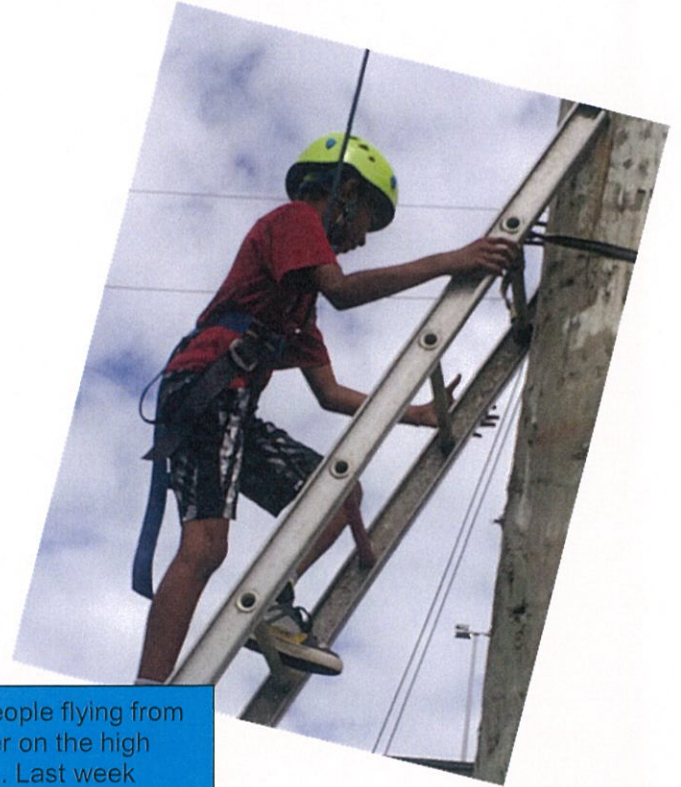


