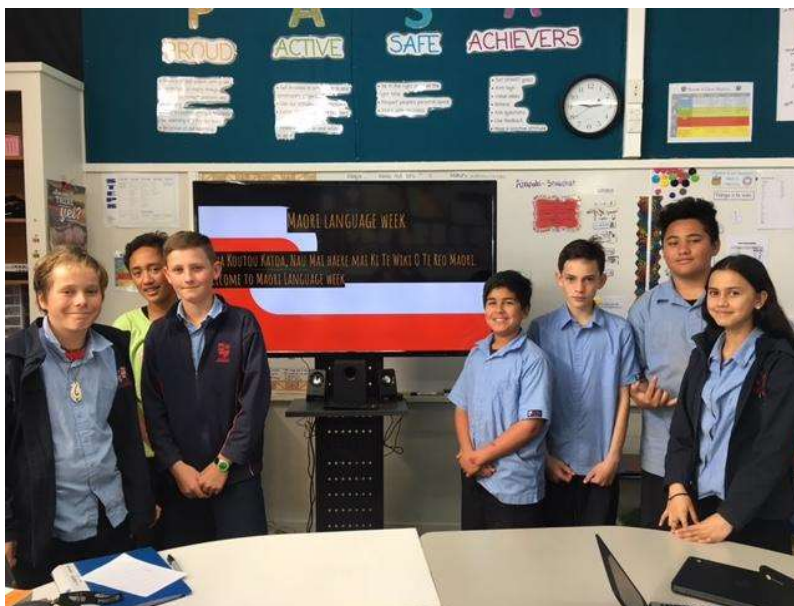
### *Te Wiki o te Reo Māori*

### **Te Mahurehure Marae Visit**



We were honoured to be invited to the Te Mahurehure Marae to share Pasadena's work with the community groups that are working on restoring on the Waititako (Meola) stream. A group of students presented our finished stop motion piece which highlights the history, current state of the stream and action required to clean it up. We plan to continue our involvement with this project. Their aim is to link all the groups working along the stream and really make a difference. Our next goal is to work on ways to reduce the rubbish blowing into the stream from Pasadena.
